DECISION

A Commission hearing was held to determine whether Top Services, Inc. d/b/a Super Liquors violated 204 CMR 2.05(2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, §34- Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (1 count).

The licensee stipulated to the facts contained in the Investigator's report dated May 29, 2009.

The report states on Friday, May 29, 2009, A.B.C.C. Investigators observed the business operation of Top Services, Inc. d/b/a Super Liquors. They noticed a youthful looking male exit Super Liquors with a pint of Southern Comfort and a twelve pack of Coors Light beer. The young man, DOB 4/20/89 (age 20) told the investigators he used a fake Wisconsin Driver's License to purchase the alcohol.

Administrative review of the file indicates the licensee had owned the business for about six (6) months prior to the violation.

The Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05(2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, §34- Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (1 count) and, therefore **suspends the license for 3 days.**
