DECISION

A hearing was held to determine whether the application of Essex Fortune Palace, Inc. ("EFP") for removal from the credit delinquency list pursuant to M.G.L. a. 138, §25 and 204 CMR 2.13(4) should be approved or disapproved.

The licensee appeared at the hearing and informed the Commission of his situation. No wholesaler that had reported a delinquency appeared at the hearing or filed any objection. Amaliada, Inc. the holder of the license that preceded EFP originally incurred the reported delinquencies. EFP was substituted to the list as required by M.G.L. c. 138, §25, ¶4. Amaliada, Inc. filed a bankruptcy, in the District of Massachusetts, Ch. 7 Docket No. 93-18497 CJK. On October 25, 1993, the Trustee's Request of No Distribution was entered. On March 24, 1997, the Court ordered the case closed and the trustee discharged.

The Commission therefore, orders that Essex Fortune Palace, Inc. be removed from the credit delinquency list.
