DECISION

Otis Associates, Inc. dba Grouse House (“the licensee”) holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws chapter 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (“the Commission”) held a hearing on June 29, 2010 regarding an alleged violation of Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jan Kujawski’s Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee’s Stipulation of Facts;
2. Compliance Check Field Report of Investigator Jan Kujawski;
3. Notice of Violation; and,
4. Underage Operative Breathalyzer Results.

There is one (1) tape of this hearing.

Facts

1. On Wednesday, March 3, 2010 at approximately 6:45 p.m., Commission investigators conducted a Minimum Age Purchase Law Compliance Check at the licensed premises of Otis Associates, Inc.
2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a Bud Light for \$2.75. The underage operative was not asked for identification.
3. Administrative review of the licensee’s file indicates this was the first violation by the licensee.

Conclusion

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. The Commission **issues a warning**.
