DECISION

Ruby Tuesday, Inc. dba Ruby Tuesday (“the licensee”) holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws chapter 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (“the Commission”) held a hearing on August 3, 2010 regarding an alleged violation of Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Dennis Keefe’s Investigative Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee’s Stipulation of Facts; and
2. Investigative Report of Investigator Dennis Keefe.

There is one (1) tape of this hearing.

Facts

1. On, June 9, 2010 at approximately 5:28 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation of Ruby Tuesday, Inc. dba Ruby Tuesday.
2. While outside of the licensed premises, Commission investigators, working with an underage operative conducted a compliance check. The underage operative entered the premises and exited with a can of Bud Light beer for \$3.52. The underage operative was not asked for identification.

Conclusion

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. As the licensee has had no previous violations the Commission **issues a warning.**
