DECISION

Its Us, Inc. dba The Island House (the “Licensee”) holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c.138,§12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the “Commission”) held a hearing on September 21, 2010 regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jamie Binienda’s Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee’s Stipulation of Facts; and
2. Compliance Check Field Report of Investigator Jamie Binienda.

There is one (1) tape of this hearing.

Facts

1. On, June 18, 2010 at approximately 6:42 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation of Its Us, Inc. dba The Island House.
2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a draft Bud Light for \$5.00. The underage operative was not asked for identification.

Conclusion

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c.138, §34. As the licensee has been in business for ten (10) years and had no previous violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
