DECISION

F & D CORPORATION DBA E Z LIQUORS
750 WASHINGTON STREET

F & D Corporation dba E Z Liquors (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws chapter 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("the Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 25, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Caroline Guarino-Wilichoski's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
2. Compliance Check Field Report of Investigator Caroline Guarino-Wilichoski.

FACTS

1. On, August 24, 2011 at approximately 8:02 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation F & D Corporation dba E Z Liquors.
2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased an eighteen (18) pack of Coors Light for eighteen dollars and zero cents (\$18.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**
