**DECISION**

**SALEM CROSS INN INC.**

Salem Cross Inn Inc. (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, June 12, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2), to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Kujawski's Compliance Check Field Report.

FACTS

1. On Saturday, March 10, 2012, at approximately 7:57 p.m., Investigators Keefe and Kujawski conducted an investigation of the business operation of Salem Cross Inn Inc.
2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a Bud Light beer for four dollars and seventy-five cents (\$4.75). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION


Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2), to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34. As the licensee has been in business for more than ten (10) years and has had no previous violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.


