DECISION

THE WRIGHT PLACE PUB, INC.
3 CENTRAL STREET
ASHBURNHAM, MA 01430

The Wright Place Pub, Inc. (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, June 24, 2014, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Bailey's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
 2. Investigator Bailey's Investigative Report dated February 20, 2014.
- A. Licensee's ServSafe Certificates for All 7 Employees

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS

1. On Thursday, February 20, 2014 at approximately 7:15 p.m., Investigators Doyle and Bailey conducted an investigation of the business operation of The Wright Place Pub, Inc.
2. An underage operative, working with investigators, purchased a Budweiser Light beer for two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Therefore, the Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**


