### Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty.

#### R E S O L V E

Concerning the Publication of the First Volume of Massachusetts Historical Records.

*Resolved,* That an edition of twelve hundred and fifty copies of the First Volume of the Colonial Records of Massachusetts be published under the direction and supervision of the committee on the library, and that, when completed, the following distribution thereof be made, to wit:—One copy to each city and town in the Commonwealth; two copies to each of the colleges and theological institutions in this State; one copy to each other college or theological institution in New England; one copy each, to the Boston and Salem Athenæums, the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, the Antiquarian Society, the Massachusetts Historical Society, the Boston Society of Natural History, the Pilgrim Society; one copy to the Library of the United States; one copy to the Library of the Smithsonian Institute; one copy to the executive of each State in the Union; and that the remaining copies be disposed of as the Legislature may hereafter direct.
