AN ACT

Extending the time for the construction of the Lebanon
Springs Railroad.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—*

1 The time within which the Lebanon Springs Rail-
2 road Company may construct that portion of their
3 railroad which was originally incorporated as the
4 "Williamstown and Hancock Railroad Company," is
5 hereby extended to April twenty-fourth, eighteen hun-
6 dred and sixty-two: *provided, however,* that the time
7 within which application to the county commissioners
8 to estimate damages for land and materials taken, as
9 provided in the fifty-eighth section of the thirty-eighth
10 chapter of the Revised Statutes, be and the same is
11 hereby extended in this case, until one year after the
12 entire road is completed and opened for use.
