### AN ACT

Concerning Attachment of Real Estate.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1. In all cases of attachment of real estate  
2 and leasehold estates on mesne process hereafter made,  
3 the officer making such attachment shall deposit  
4 the copy of the writ with his return, as now required  
5 by law, in the office of the register of deeds for the  
6 county or district in which the estate so attached  
7 lies, instead of the office of the clerk of the court.

1    SECT. 2. All laws relating to attachment of real  
2 estate and leasehold estates now in force, shall apply to

3 attachments made under the provisions of the preced-  
4 ing section, except that registers of deeds shall per-  
5 form the duties in relation thereto now required of  
6 clerks of courts, and no deposit hereafter of the  
7 original writ or copy in the clerk's office shall be re-  
8 quired, or give any force or effect to any attachment  
9 of such estates.

1     SECT. 2. This act shall take effect on and after  
2 the first day of July next.
