

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SALARIES AND EXPENSES OF THE DISTRICT POLICE. *Chap. 35*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

- SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for the purposes specified, for the eleven months ending on the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and six, to wit: —
- For the salary of the chief of the district police, twenty-two hundred ninety-one dollars and sixty-six cents. Appropriations.  
Chief of district police.
  - For the salary of the first clerk in the office of the district police, thirteen hundred and seventy-five dollars. First clerk.
  - For the salary of the second clerk in the office of the district police, nine hundred sixteen dollars and sixty-six cents. Second clerk.
  - For postage, printing, stationery, telephone, telegraph, and incidental and contingent office expenses in the department of the district police, a sum not exceeding forty-five hundred eighty-three dollars and thirty-three cents. Expenses.
  - For the printing and binding of the annual report, a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars. Annual report.

DETECTIVE DEPARTMENT.

- For the salary of the deputy chief of the detective department of the district police, twenty-two hundred dollars. Deputy chief of detective department.
- For the salary of the clerk in the detective department of the district police, eleven hundred dollars. Clerk.
- For the salary of the stenographer in the detective department of the district police, eleven hundred dollars. Stenographer.
- For the compensation of the members of the detective department of the district police, a sum not exceeding nineteen thousand five hundred and twenty-five dollars. Members, compensation.
- For the compensation of the fire inspectors of the detective department of the district police, ninety-nine hundred dollars. Fire inspectors.
- For travelling expenses of the members of the detective department of the district police, a sum not exceeding eleven thousand five hundred and fifty dollars. Travelling expenses.
- For special services and expenses of persons employed under the direction of the deputy chief of the detective department in the investigation of fires, including witness Special services, etc.

fees, travel, contingent and incidental expenses, a sum not exceeding thirteen hundred and seventy-five dollars.

## INSPECTION DEPARTMENT.

**Deputy chief of inspection department.** For the salary of the deputy chief of the inspection department of the district police, twenty-two hundred dollars.

**Clerk.** For the salary of the clerk in the inspection department of the district police, five hundred and fifty dollars.

**Members, compensation.** For the compensation of the members of the inspection department of the district police, a sum not exceeding fifty thousand four hundred sixteen dollars and sixty-six cents.

**Travelling expenses.** For travelling expenses of the members of the inspection department of the district police, a sum not exceeding thirteen thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars.

**Operating the steamer Lexington.** For the expenses of operating the steamer Lexington which is in charge of the chief of the district police and used in the enforcement of the fishery laws of the Commonwealth, a sum not exceeding nine thousand dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Chap. 36** AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SALARIES AND EXPENSES OF THE MASSACHUSETTS HIGHWAY COMMISSION.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

**Appropriations.** SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for the purposes specified, for the eleven months ending on the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and six, to wit: —

**Massachusetts highway commission.** For the salaries of the Massachusetts highway commission, the sum of seventy-seven hundred ninety-one dollars and sixty-six cents.

**Engineers, clerks, etc.** For the salaries of the engineers, clerks and assistants in the office of the commission, a sum not exceeding thirteen thousand one hundred twenty-six dollars and sixty-six cents.

**Expenses.** For travelling and other expenses of the commission, printing, postage and necessary office expenses, a sum not exceeding fifty-nine hundred fifty-eight dollars and thirty-three cents.
