AN ACT

To extend the time for Constructing and Locating the
New London Northern Railroad.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The time fixed by the act of February
2 eight, eighteen hundred and sixty-four, for the con-
3 struction of the New London Northern Railroad is
4 hereby extended one year.

1 SECT. 2. In order to correct any informality or
2 insufficiency in the location of said railroad heretofore
3 filed, the New London Railroad Company is hereby
4 authorized at any time within one year from the pas-
5 sage of this act, to file with the county commissioners
6 of the counties of Hampshire and Franklin respec-
7 tively, new localities of said railroad, defining the

8 courses and distances, and boundaries of such portions
9 thereof as lie within the said counties respectively, in
10 conformity with the actual construction of said road,
11 which said new location when filed shall be valid and
12 sufficient in law, to all intents and purposes.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect from and
2 after its passage.
