AN ACT

Relating to the Springfield Fire and Marine Insurance Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The Springfield Fire and Marine Insur-
2 ance Company is hereby authorized to increase its
3 capital stock to a sum not exceeding five hundred
4 thousand dollars, said increase to be divided into
5 shares of one hundred dollars each, and to be paid in
6 within three years from the passage of this act, in
7 such instalments as the corporation shall from time
8 to time determine, and be invested according to the
9 laws of the Commonwealth.

1 SECT. 2. Said corporation shall be, remain and
2 continue a corporation, from and after the fourteenth

3 day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand
4 eight hundred and sixty-nine, in like manner and to
5 the same effect as if the act incorporating said com-
6 pany had contained no limitation of time; with all
7 the powers and privileges, and subject to all the
8 duties, liabilities and restrictions set forth in all gen-
9 eral laws that are now, or hereafter may be, in force
10 relating to such corporations.
