IN SENATE, February 19, 1866.

The Committee appointed to superintend the destruction of the plates and unissued bonds in the treasurer's hands, report that they have seen the following property destroyed, (the bonds having been burnt in one of the furnaces of the State House, and the plates having been destroyed at the Norway Iron Works in South Boston,) viz. :—

- 140 Back Bay Lands bonds, \$500 each, not signed.
- 309 Coast Defence bonds, \$1,000 each, not signed.
- 1 plate Coast Defence, \$1,000 bond.
- 1 " War Fund, \$500 bond.
- 1 " Union Fund, \$500 bond.
- 1 " " " 28 coupons of \$30 each.
- 1 " " " 32 " of \$12.50 each.
- 1 " War Fund, 40 coupons of \$15 each.
- 1 " Union Fund, 10 coupons of \$15 each.
- 1 " Bounty Fund, 40 coupons of \$25 each.
- 1 " " " 20 " of \$25 each.
- 1 " " " 60 " of \$12.50 each.
- 1 " War Fund, 40 coupons of \$30 each.
- 1 " Coast Defence, 30 coupons of \$25 each.
- 1 " " " 10 " of \$25 each.
- 4 " Old Issue, 1812, '13, and '14, copper plates, with 17 plates, blanks for amount.
