AN ACT

To extend the time for the Location and Construction of the Springfield and Longmeadow Railroad.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 The time for the location and construction of the
2 Springfield and Longmeadow Railroad is hereby
3 extended three years from the time designated in the
4 eighty-first chapter of the acts of the year eighteen
5 hundred and sixty-four.
