### AN ACT

To authorize the Springfield Five Cents Savings Bank to hold Real Estate.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1. The Springfield Five Cents Savings Bank  
2 is hereby authorized to hold real estate to the amount  
3 of thirty thousand dollars.

1    SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
