AN ACT

Concerning the Boston, Hartford and Erie Railroad
Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The Boston, Hartford and Erie Railroad
2 Company, are hereby empowered to locate, construct
3 and maintain a railroad in the town of Blackstone,
4 commencing about three hundred and thirty-five feet
5 from the east end of the bridge of said company over
6 the Blackstone river west of the Blackstone depot,
7 and extending easterly about six hundred feet to the
8 state line, between Massachusetts and Rhode Island.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
