AN ACT

Concerning the Amherst Branch Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1 SECT. 1. The time for the location and construc-
2 tion of the railroad of the Amherst Branch Railroad
3 Company, is hereby extended three years from the
4 time designated in the one hundred and forty-seventh
5 chapter of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and
6 sixty-four.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
