Mr. BRIGHAM proposes the following amendments to the "Bill to regulate the hours of labor in manufacturing corporations," (Senate 239,) by striking out section first and insert the following:—

1 SECT. 1. No child under the age of ten years shall
2 be employed in any manufacturing establishment
3 within this Commonwealth; and none between the
4 ages of ten and fourteen years shall be so employed,
5 unless he has attended school at least three months
6 during the year next preceding such employment;
7 nor shall such employment continue unless such child
8 shall attend school at least three months in each and
9 every year.

Also, in section second strike out the words "the sum of" in the third line, and insert, "a sum not exceeding." Also, strike out all of section second after "offence," in the third line.
