AN ACT

Relative to the Social Library of Taunton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1 SECT. 1. “The proprietors of the Social Library
2 in the town of Taunton ” may, upon the vote or writ-
3 ten consent of two-thirds of the proprietors and share-
4 holders, transfer and assign their library and other
5 property to the city of Taunton, to be owned and used
6 by the city as a part of its public library: *provided,*
7 that any proprietor or shareholder who is not now a
8 resident of Taunton, shall have the right to use the
9 public library of Taunton during his life, in the same
10 manner and under the same regulations that the citi-
11 zens of Taunton, may or shall hereafter be allowed to
12 use the same.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect on its passage.
