In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-Six,

RESOLVE

In relation to Claims of H. Haupt and Company.

Resolved, That the governor and council are authorized to appoint a commission of three persons to examine and report to the governor and council upon any claims of H. Haupt and Company, which they may deem equitable and just, for labor, service, machinery, materials and land damages, or any payments and expenditures in the construction of the Troy and Greenfield Railroad and Hoosac Tunnel; and the governor and council may provide for the payment of the same in such manner as they may deem expedient, a sum sufficient for which purpose is hereby appropriated; and the governor and council may order the release of any claims of the Commonwealth against said Haupt and Company or H. Haupt, connected with or growing out of the construction of said railroad and tunnel, which in their judgment, justice and equity require should be released.
