On the Petition of E. P. Brownell and Restcome Macomber,
Selectmen of the Town of Westport.

Resolved, That for the reasons set out in said petition, there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth, to said Brownell and Macomber, the sum of seventy dollars and ninety-six cents; sixty-five dollars thereof for the benefit of George H. Tripp, a minor son of Jeremiah D. Tripp of Westport, and the balance thereof for the benefit of the family of said Jeremiah D. Tripp.
