### AN ACT

In further addition to an Act in aid of the Families of  
Volunteers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1 The provisions of the second section of the act to  
2 which this act is in addition, being chapter sixty-six  
3 of the acts of the present session, shall be deemed to  
4 apply to those volunteers, who, although not inhabi-  
5 tants of the Commonwealth at the time of enlistment,  
6 have become such by the establishment of the boun-  
7 dary line between the states of Massachusetts and  
8 Rhode Island.
