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### R E S O L V E

In favor of Bristol County Agricultural Society.

*Resolved*, For reasons set forth in the petition of Theodore Dean and others, that there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth to Timothy Gorden, treasurer of Bristol County Agricultural Society, the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, the same being in full for damage to buildings, fences, trees, grass and other things while occupied as Camp Old Colony.
