Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth to the Mayor of Lawrence, for the benefit of Michael Green, the sum of sixty-six dollars, in full payment for services rendered as member of Company I, Sixth Regiment Massachusetts Volunteer Militia, and for injuries received at Baltimore on the nineteenth day of April, 1861.
