## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

### AN ACT

Fixing the Salaries of Judges, Registers and Assistant-  
Registers of Probate and Insolvency.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1. Judges, registers and assistant-registers  
2 shall receive from the treasury of the Commonwealth  
3 annual salaries, as follows:—

4    For the county of Suffolk: the judge and register,  
5 each three thousand dollars; and the assistant-register,  
6 fifteen hundred dollars.

7    For the county of Middlesex: the judge, twenty-  
8 five hundred dollars; the register, two thousand dol-  
9 lars; and the assistant-register, one thousand dollars.

10   For the county of Essex: the judge, twenty-five  
11 hundred dollars; the register, two thousand dollars;  
12 and the assistant-register, one thousand dollars.

13   For the county of Worcester: the judge, twenty-

14 five hundred dollars; the register, two thousand dol-  
15 lars; and the assistant-register, one thousand dollars.

16 For the county of Norfolk: the judge, two thousand  
17 dollars; the register, fifteen hundred dollars; and  
18 the assistant-register, eight hundred dollars.

19 For the county of Bristol: the judge, fifteen hun-  
20 dred dollars; and the register, thirteen hundred dol-  
21 lars.

22 For the county of Hampden: the judge, thirteen  
23 hundred dollars; and the register, twelve hundred  
24 dollars.

25 For the county of Plymouth: the judge, thirteen  
26 hundred dollars; and the register, twelve hundred  
27 dollars.

28 For the county of Berkshire: the judge, twelve  
29 hundred dollars; and the register, twelve hundred  
30 dollars.

31 For the county of Hampshire: the judge, nine  
32 hundred dollars; and the register, nine hundred  
33 dollars.

34 For the county of Barnstable: the judge, nine  
35 hundred dollars; and the register, nine hundred  
36 dollars.

37 For the county of Franklin: the judge, nine hun-  
38 dred dollars; and the register, nine hundred dollars.

39 For the county of Nantucket: the judge, five hun-  
40 dred dollars; and the register, six hundred dollars.

41 For the county of Dukes county: the judge, five  
42 hundred dollars; and the register, six hundred dol-  
43 lars.

44 And all such salaries shall be paid from the first  
45 day of January last.

1    SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent  
2 with the provisions hereof are hereby repealed.

1    SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
