The Committee on Probate and Chancery, to whom was referred the Order of January 11th, relative to changing times and places of Probate Courts in the county of Barnstable, having considered the matter, report the accompanying Bill.

AN ACT

Fixing the times of holding Probate Courts in the
County of Barnstable.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. Courts of probate shall be held in the
2 county of Barnstable as follows: at Barnstable on the
3 second Tuesdays of January, February, March, August
4 and September, and on the third Tuesdays of April,
5 June and September; at Harwich, on the second
6 Monday after the first Tuesday of May, and on the
7 second Monday of October; at Wellfleet, on the third
8 Tuesday after the second Monday of October; at
9 Provincetown on Wednesday next after the third
10 Tuesday of May and on Wednesday next after the
11 second Monday of October; and at Falmouth, on the
12 third Tuesday in November, instead of the times now
13 provided by law.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect on the first day
2 of July next.
