### AN ACT

To amend an Act in relation to the Inspection and Meas-  
urement of Leather.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of  
the same, as follows:—*

1 The provisions of chapter two hundred and thirty-  
2 six of the acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-six, are  
3 hereby further extended to require the name of the  
4 inspector to be stamped upon each side or roll of  
5 leather measured and inspected as therein prescribed.
