AN ACT

To extend the time for the Location and Construction of the Graves End Branch Street Railroad, and to increase its Capital Stock.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The time for accepting the act to incor-
2 porate the Graves End Branch Street Railroad Com-
3 pany, approved February seventeen, eighteen hundred
4 and sixty-eight, and for the location and construction
5 of its road, is hereby extended two years.

1 SECT. 2. Said company may construct its road
2 from some convenient point or points in ward four
3 or five, in the city of Lynn, to some convenient point
4 or points in wards one, two and three.

1 SECT. 3. The second section of said act is hereby
2 so amended that the capital stock of said company
3 shall not exceed fifty thousand dollars.

1 SECT. 4. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
