AN ACT

To confirm certain Acts done by James T. Robinson as a Commissioner to Administer Oaths to Public Officers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1 All acts done by James T. Robinson, of Adams, in
2 the county of Berkshire, as a commissioner to admin-
3 ister oaths to public officers, between the twenty-ninth
4 day of January, in the year eighteen hundred and
5 fifty-nine, and the first day of April, in the year
6 eighteen hundred and seventy, are hereby made valid
7 and confirmed to the same extent as though he had
8 been during that time qualified to discharge the
9 duties of said office.
