## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy.

### R E S O L V E

For the Improvement of Salem Harbor.

*Resolved,* That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth, to the city of Salem, a sum not exceeding fifteen thousand dollars, and not exceeding one-half the cost of protecting and improving the inner harbor of Salem, under the direction of the harbor commissioners, and in substantial accordance with the suggestions contained in their report for eighteen hundred and sixty-eight; and payment to be made upon a certificate of the harbor commissioners of the cost and completion of the work.

*provided a like sum be subscribed  
by the City or other parties  
when the payment is made by the  
Treasurer.*
