R E S O L V E

For the temporary Relief of Disabled Soldiers and the Families of the Slain.

Resolved, That the unexpended balance of the appropriation made in chapter sixty-two of the resolves of eighteen hundred and sixty-nine, amounting to three thousand seven hundred and twenty-two dollars and forty-two cents, for the benefit of discharged soldiers, may be expended by the surgeon-general, under the direction of the governor and council, for the temporary relief of disabled soldiers and the families of the slain.
