AN ACT

To change the name of the Hinkley and Williams Works.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECT. 1. The Hinkley and Williams Works, a
2 corporation organized under the General Statutes
3 of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and hav-
4 ing its usual place of business at Boston, shall
5 hereafter be called and known by the name of
6 "The Hinkley Locomotive Works," which shall
7 be its legal name.

1 SECT. 2. The act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
