Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury to Caroline L. Osgood the sum of seventeen dollars and seventy-three cents, to George Osborn the sum of forty dollars and thirty-seven cents, to Jonathan King the sum of fifty-four dollars and twenty-nine cents, and to Eben U. King the sum of thirteen dollars and ninety-two cents, for taxes severally paid by them a second time upon the same bank stock, in the year eighteen hundred and seventy-two.
