## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy-Three.

### AN ACT

Authorizing the New Haven and Northampton Company to increase its Capital Stock.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1    SECT. 1. That the New Haven and Northamp-  
2    ton Company is hereby authorized to increase its  
3    capital stock by adding thereto a sum not exceed-  
4    ing two million dollars, to be divided into shares  
5    of one hundred dollars each, to be issued in such  
6    manner as the directors of said company shall  
7    determine: *provided*, that the capital stock of said  
8    company shall not, at any time, exceed the cost of  
9    its railroad, stations and equipments.

1    SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2    passage.
