AN ACT

To incorporate the New England Lodge Associates
in the City of Cambridge.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECT. 1. James M. Price, Frederick Goodfellow
2 and George L. Mitchell, their associates and suc-
3 cessors, are hereby made a corporation by the name
4 of "The New England Lodge Associates," for
5 the purpose of purchasing or erecting a building
6 in the city of Cambridge, and maintaining the
7 same for the purposes of an Odd Fellows' hall and
8 for any other lawful purposes; with all the powers
9 and privileges, and subject to all the duties, restric-
10 tions and liabilities set forth in all general laws
11 which now are or hereafter may be in force appli-
12 cable to such corporations.

1 SECT. 2. The capital stock of said corporation
2 shall not exceed seventy-five thousand dollars, and
3 said corporation may hold for the purposes afore-

4 said real and personal estate not exceeding the
5 amount of the capital stock: *provided*, that no
6 liability shall be incurred until ten thousand
7 dollars of its capital stock has been paid in in
8 cash.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
