### RESOLVE.

Providing for printing Extra Copies of the Report of the Commission on Drainage.

*Resolved*, That there be printed four thousand extra copies of the report of the commission on drainage, to be distributed as follows: ten copies to each member of the Senate and House of Representatives, and one copy to each head of department and others, in the same manner as is now provided by law for the distribution of public documents, the balance to be deposited with the secretary of the Commonwealth for distribution at his discretion. The books shall be bound in muslin, and the total cost to the Commonwealth for this edition shall not exceed the sum of three thousand six hundred dollars.
