AN ACT

To change the Name of the Working Union of Progressive Spiritualists of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The name of the "Working Union
2 of Progressive Spiritualists," of Boston, a corpo-
3 ration established under the laws of the Common-
4 wealth, is changed to "Spiritual Fraternity."

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
