RESOLVE

In favor of the Trustees of the Soldiers' Home in Massachusetts.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth to the trustees of the
3 Soldiers' Home in Massachusetts the sum of twenty thou-
4 sand dollars, the same to be used towards the main-
5 tenance of a home for deserving soldiers and sailors.
