AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Stoneham to refund Certain Taxes and Interest thereon.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Stoneham is author-
2 ized to repay to R. R. Danforth the sum of two
3 hundred and sixty-one dollars and seventy-four
4 cents pursuant to a vote of said town.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
