RESOLVE

In favor of Lucretia D. Durgin, Administratrix.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth, to Lucretia D. Durgin,
3 as she is administratrix of the estate of Edmund Durgin,
4 late of Boston, deceased, the sum of four hundred fifty-
5 nine dollars and sixty-three cents, as full compensation
6 for filling in certain lands and flats belonging to the Com-
7 monwealth at Prison Point, so called, in the Charlestown
8 District of Boston, near the track of the Eastern Railroad
9 Company, by said Edmund Durgin before his decease.
