RESOLVE

In favor of Annie Fitzgerald of North Adams.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth, from the first day of
3 January, eighteen hundred and eighty-eight, to Annie
4 Fitzgerald of North Adams, an annuity of one hundred
5 dollars for the term of five years, to be used by her in
6 supporting James Haggerty, the minor son of the late
7 Patrick Haggerty, who was killed in the Hoosac Tunnel
8 on the eleventh day of January, eighteen hundred and
9 eighty-five, while in the employ of the Commonwealth,
10 to be paid in equal quarterly instalments; said annuity
11 shall cease should the said James Haggerty die before
12 the expiration of the time provided in this resolve.
