### AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses at  
the State Farm at Bridgewater.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are  
2 appropriated to be paid, out of the treasury of the  
3 Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the  
4 payment of salaries and expenses at the state farm  
5 at Bridgewater, during the year ending on the  
6 thirty-first day of December, eighteen hundred  
7 and eighty-eight, to wit: —

8 For the payment of salaries, wages and labor at  
9 the state farm at Bridgewater, a sum not exceed-  
10 ing fifteen thousand three hundred dollars; and  
11 for current expenses at said institution, a sum not

12 exceeding forty thousand three hundred dollars.
