RESOLVE

Providing for the Publication of a Digest of the Decisions
of the Board of Railroad Commissioners.

1 *Resolved*, That the Board of Railroad Commissioners
2 be authorized, if they deem it expedient, to secure for
3 publication a digest of the decisions of said board and
4 to have one thousand copies thereof printed, provided
5 that the expense of the preparation of said digest shall
6 not exceed two hundred and fifty dollars, which expense,
7 together with the cost of printing, shall be borne by the
8 several corporations owning or operating railroads or
9 street railways, as provided in the Public Statutes, chap-
10 ter 112 section 12.
