AN ACT

In Relation to Voting by Proxy in Corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section twenty-seven of chapter
2 one hundred and six of the Public Statutes is
3 hereby amended by striking out at the end
4 thereof the words, "and no person shall as proxy
5 and attorney cast more than fifty votes, unless all
6 the shares so represented by him are owned by
7 one person"; and section fifty-four of chapter
8 one hundred and twelve of the Public Statutes is
9 hereby amended by striking out at the end
10 thereof the words, "no person shall as proxy or
11 attorney cast more than fifty votes unless all the
12 shares so represented by him are owned by one
13 person."

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
