AN ACT

Concerning the Printing and Distribution of Certain Public Documents.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. There shall be printed annually
2 fifteen thousand copies of the report of the
3 secretary of the state board of agriculture; and
4 twenty-five thousand copies of the report of the
5 board of control of the state agricultural experi-
6 ment station.

1 SECT. 2. Of the reports of the board of
2 control of the state agricultural experiment
3 station provided for in section one of this chapter,
4 fifteen thousand copies thereof shall be bound
5 with the reports of the secretary of the state
6 board of agriculture, and eight thousand copies
7 thereof shall be for the use of the said board of
8 control.
