RESOLVE

Providing for a Stable, Carriage-house, Coal-shed and Certain other Improvements at the Westborough Insane Hospital.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding
3 twelve thousand dollars, to be expended at the West-
4 borough Insane Hospital at Westborough, under the di-
5 rection of the trustees, for the following purposes, to wit:
6 for building a stable, carriage-house and vegetable cellar,
7 a sum not exceeding five thousand dollars; for building
8 an ice-house and coal-shed a sum not exceeding one
9 thousand dollars; for construction of a fire-line and
10 hydrants to barn and out-buildings a sum not exceeding
11 two thousand dollars; for a carriage for patients a sum
12 not exceeding four hundred dollars; for the purchase of
13 cows and oxen a sum not exceeding six hundred dollars;
14 and for reconstructing roof, for catches on roof for snow
15 and ice, a sum not exceeding three thousand dollars.
