AN ACT

To confirm the Proceedings of the Last Annual
Town Meeting of the Town of Brookfield.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The proceedings of the last an-
2 nual town meeting of the town of Brookfield
3 held on the first Monday of April in the year one
4 thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight shall
5 not be invalid by reason of any clerical error in
6 the warrant calling said meeting; and the election
7 of town officers and all other doings of said meet-
8 ing are hereby ratified and confirmed.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
