RESOLVE

Providing for a New Building and for Certain Repairs at the
Lyman School for Boys at Westborough.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding
3 eight thousand dollars to be expended at the Lyman
4 School for Boys at Westborough under the direction of
5 the trustees of said institution, to provide additional
6 accommodations for the increased number of boys, and
7 for the erection of a building for the use of the super-
8 intendent and officers of said school.
